How to Turn On Captions on TikTok



- Captions are automatic subtitles overlaying TikTok videos, enhancing accessibility and inclusivity.
- They support multiple languages and are invaluable for the deaf, hard of hearing, or anyone watching videos on mute.

How to Turn On Captions

- Open TikTok and browse videos.
- Look for the small text box icon on the left side of the screen above the video info.
- Tap the icon to activate captions and adjust size and position as needed.

Editing Captions on Your Videos

- Create or upload a video, then tap the check mark to enter editing mode.
- Select the Captions option on the right side of the screen and agree to terms.
- TikTok generates captions; review and edit for accuracy. Tap Save when done.

Disabling Captions on Your Videos

- Go to your profile and tap the video you want to edit.
- Tap the three dots icon and select Edit video.
- Toggle off the Captions switch, tap Save, then Done.
